

Blood Donation Drive

Date:- 24th January 2026

The NSS Unit of Aryabhata College participated in the “Blood Donation Drive” organized by Viksit Prayas Foundation in collaboration with AIIMS Blood Bank. The Viksit Prayas Foundation is a non-profit organisation registered under the *Indian Trust Act, 1882*, affiliated with *NITI Ayog* and certified under *12A & 80G*. Dedicated to social welfare and community development, the foundation partners with institutions to promote health, education, and awareness initiatives. For this drive, it collaborated with the AIIMS Blood Bank and Sankalp Ram Parivar to ensure safe blood collection and wider community outreach. The Blood Donation Drive was held Near Reliance Smart Mall, Najafgarh. All five NSS volunteers reported at the event venue by 11:30 AM. Once the blood donation drive commenced, they were asked to fill out consent forms which included personal and health-related details.



Following this, the volunteers were escorted in pairs into the AIIMS mobile blood donation van, where nurses first collected a small blood sample to check their haemoglobin levels. As per medical standards, the normal haemoglobin range is approximately 13.8–17.2 g/dL for males and 12.1–15.1 g/dL for females. Only those meeting the minimum threshold were eligible to donate blood. The volunteers were able to Donate blood one after another. After completing this praiseworthy act, they were awarded with certificates presented personally by the Chief Guest, Smt. Kamaljeet Sehrawat, Honourable Member of Parliament, West Delhi and the Founder Aartii Dhingra herself.



The act of donating blood is one of the simplest yet most powerful ways to save lives, and the event successfully conveyed this message to everyone present. NSS volunteers played a vital role by participating with enthusiasm, demonstrating how youth can lead by example in serving society. Their contribution, along with the involvement of members of the Foundation, and local residents, showed that such initiatives thrive when the responsibility is shared across the community.

The drive created awareness and inspired many to consider voluntary blood donation in the future. By coming together for this noble cause, the event reinforced the idea that every individual has the power to make a difference, and that acts of service whether big or small can ripple outward to build a healthier and more empathetic society. Our dedicated NSS volunteers who stepped forward to donate blood today for this selfless act, reflected the true motto of the National Service Scheme – Not Me, But You. Through your commitment to social service and humanity, you have shown that real service lies in action.
