Summary Of The Event-:

Report on the visit of FIC Aryabhatta College to ONGC to commemorate Ambedkar Jayanti with Ladli Foundation.

Project Samarth aims to spread financial literacy to the different sections of society and teach the torchbearers of tomorrow something that books and schools never taught them. FIC Aryabhatta is in collaboration with the Laadli foundation for its social initiative project SAMARTH.

The Laadli foundation works to uplift vulnerable people in both rural and urban areas. Under this, the team of FIC Aryabhatta College visited the ONGC office to commemorate Ambedkar Jayanti with the Ladli Foundation. The event was aimed at bringing people's attention towards the ideals of Dr. Bhimrao

Ambedkar, i.e. One goal, One mission, Education for all, under which tablets were distributed among seventy five children along with three years of free education in collaboration with Byjus.



Bhimrao Ambedkar believed that education was the only key to a better future. He himself struggled a lot before reaching a stage where he is known and celebrated by the entire nation. In a short span of time, Ambedkar made provisions in the constitution that ensured education to all, especially the underprivileged sections of the society. He battled injustice and raised his voice against social evils and provided a better future for the citizens of our country, thus affecting thousands of lives.

Before the event commenced, a short presentation was given on the security measures in place in case of any contingency, followed by the presentation of the inspiring ONGC song. Then we moved forward in welcoming the guests present for the event, Mr. Shashi Prasad, Mr. BS Maruti and two others with a plant, followed by the diya lighting ceremony to honour Dr. BR Ambedkar.



Moving forward, Mr Devendra Kumar gave a speech on the importance of education. He stressed upon Ambedkar's principle that one needs to be educated in order to make a place for them in the world. Next came Mr. Shashi Prasad, who extended ONGC's support to the SC/ST students. He said that ONGC doesn't believe in providing help one time to the beneficiaries, but in making the beneficiaries self-sufficient. Mr. Vijay Prakash also extended his gratitude towards the project.

ONGC and Laadli Foundation have been associated with each other for a long period of time and have also won 2 national awards.

Mr. Devendra Kumar, a social reformer and innovator, also the head of Laadli Foundation, then gave a brief about the project. The project is carried out on a huge scale with a lot of investment and the students wouldn't have dreamt of something as big as this. Giving them a digital device is like giving them wings. For the maximum utilization, the device comes along with resources for standards 8,9,10,IITJEE, and NEET preparation. He said that in the next 6 months, impact assessment and capacity building will also be done for these students. Out of the 71 women who attended the event, 41 got selected.

The event concluded with a musical performance by performers singing songs about Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar and participants were later on provided with refreshments.
