DISPUTO '21



INAUGURATION





Feedback Session:






HINDI CONVENTIONAL DEBATE

Hindi Conventional Debate was conducted on 27th April 2021 with 17 teams. Each team consisted of two members one speaker for the motion and the other against the motion.








HINDI CONVENTIONAL DEBATE

Feedback Session:




Feedback Session:


