Introduction

Techpioneers, the Computer Science Society of Aryabhata College, organized a seminar on “Soft Skills” on 15th October 2019 in the Seminar Room.

The seminar aimed to help students prepare for giving better job interviews and highlighted the importance of internships. Thirty five students from I, II and III year of B.Sc.(Hons) Computer Science participated in this workshop. The resource persons were Ms. Ashima and Ms. Akshita from “The Discovery” team.

Objective of the workshop

The main objective of this seminar was to sensitize the students with the interview and internship process.

Prerequisites

Students did not require any prerequisite knowledge or skills.

This workshop was for I, II, and III year students of B. Sc. (H) Computer Science Department, Aryabhata College.

The Seminar

Interested participants filled a Google form to confirm their participation.

The participants filled a Candidate Information form, one day before the seminar. This helped the trainers in gauging their expectations from the session.

The seminar began with a brief introduction of the participants. The students were then enlightened on the significance of “Soft Skills”, such as body language, leadership qualities, team work, time management, multi-tasking etc. required for the one's personality development and integral for better performance in an interview.

Students were given tips on making an attractive resume, how to respond to various common questions asked in an interview process by different departments of an organization.

The session was an interactive one as the speakers welcomed the questions from students and responded with effective answers. The speakers then laid stress on the body postures one should maintain while giving an interview along with etiquette to be followed.

The seminar ended with a question answer round.
