
**Event:** Movie Screening and Discussion

On 5th March 2025, the Gender Sensitization Committee of Aryabhatta College successfully organized a movie screening and discussion session titled Redefining the Norms: Men Negotiating with Patriarchy. The event aimed to foster critical conversations around gender roles and societal stereotypes that restrict individual choices and personal growth.

The movie screened, Sonu Beauty Parlour, revolved around the life of Sonu, a talented makeup artist. Despite his exceptional skills, Sonu faced societal pressures and patriarchal stereotypes that forced him to suppress his passion.
