The major outcomes arising from the deliberations and proposals of IQAC meetings held during the period 2015 -16 to 2020-21 are mentioned below with brief details:

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1. Add-On Courses

Academic Year 2016-17

Integrated Course on Financial Markets (100 hours)

The Add-on Courses Cell of Aryabhatta College successfully conducted an add-on course, "Integrated Course on Financial Markets" (ICFM) in academic year 2016-17 with the collaboration of Bombay Stock Exchange Institute Limited (BIL). This course helped creating the knowledge and insights on Capital Markets and was successfully concluded on 21st April 2017 by awarding certification to 34 students from various courses of Aryabhatta college i.e. B.A (H.)-Business Economics, B.A. (H.) Economics, B.Com. (H.), B. Com., B.A. Program).



Academic Year 2017-18

Advance Skill Programme on Financial Markets (100 hours)

The Add-on Courses Cell of Aryabhatta College conducted a 100 hours add-on course titled "Advance Skill Programme on Financial Markets" in collaboration with Advance Institute of Financial Markets and Research (AIFMR) and under the certification from National Institute for Entrepreneurship and Small Business Development (NIESBUD), Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, Government of India, from October 2017 to March 2018. The course immensely helped the students in creating their knowledge and insights on financial markets and 70 students from various courses of Aryabhatta college and other colleges under University of Delhi, viz., SGTB Khalsa College, Janki Devi Memorial College, received their dual certification from Aryabhatta College along with AIFMR and NIESBUD (Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship), Government of India.





Academic Year 2018-19

Advance Program in Financial Modelling (100 hours)

The Add-on Courses Cell also completed the 100 hours course titled "Advance Program in Financial Modelling" in collaboration with IMS Pro-school and under the certification from National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC), Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, GOI, from March 2018 to January 2019. The course was successfully concluded on 29th January 2019 by awarding certification to 45 students from various courses of Aryabhatta College (Bachelor of Management Studies, B.A. (H) Business Economics, B.A. (H) in Economics, B. Com. (H), B. Com., B. A.) and other colleges of University of Delhi, viz., Ram Lal Anand College, Shaheed Bhagat Singh College, Keshav Mahavidyalaya, and also from other Universities, viz., Delhi Technical University and Guru Gobind Singh Indraprastha University. The students received their dual certification from Aryabhatta College along with IMS Pro-school and NSDC (Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship), Government of India.





Advance Skill Programme on Financial Markets (100 hours)

The Add-on Courses Cell of Aryabhatta College conducted a 100 hours add-on course titled "Advance Skill Programme on Financial Markets" in collaboration with Advance Institute of Financial Markets and Research (AIFMR) and under the certification from National Institute for Entrepreneurship and Small Business Development (NIESBUD), Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship, Government of India, during academic year 2018-19. The course was successfully concluded on 12 April 2019 by awarding certification [dual certification from Aryabhatta College along with AIFMR and NIESBUD (Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship), Government of India] to 58 students from Aryabhatta College and other colleges of University of Delhi such as Hansraj College, Maitreyi College, Gargi College, SGTB Khalsa College and School of Open Learning.





French Language Course (108 hours)

The Add-on Courses Cell has also successfully conducted 108 hours "French Language Course for Beginners" in collaboration with Alliance Française, Delhi (AFD), affiliated to French Embassy in India. The course was successfully concluded on 22nd May 2019 by awarding certification to the students of Aryabhatta College and other colleges of University of Delhi.



Microsoft MOS Certification Course








Japanese Language Course (80 hours)






"Applications of SPSS in Conducting Research"




Canva Workshop




A webinar on career in financialmarket was conducted by Mr. Aman Chawla which provided insights to the students on how they can build their career in stockmarket.

Industrial Trip Report of the Department of Management Studies

With the insight of inculcating the essence on how the Biz-World actually operates, Department of Management Studies (DoMS), Aryabhatta College arranged its Annual Industrial Trip on April 9th, 2019 at Alankit Assignments Limited.

Alankit Assignments Limited is a part of the Alankit Group which commenced its operations in 1991. It offers a bouquet of services including e-Governance, PAN Facilitation, Equity & Commodity Broking, Wealth & Portfolio Management Systems. It has a humongous customer base of 17 million and has portrayed sky-rocketing growth throughout its inception.

A muster of 60 management students intuitively entered Alankit House with a keen spirit to enhance their grey matter. The session was



opened by Mrs. Komal Wadhawan, Manager (Training) briefing about the future course of action. The session was divided into four parts with comprehensive discussion of the same. Firstly, the students were provided insights on the working of financial markets in India by representatives of NSDL (National Securities Depositary Ltd.). They gave a review on the structure of financial markets in India and the importance of a De-Materialized Account in present day.

The session continued with exploration of Online Trading in the equity market (NSE). The speakers executed a live trade explaining various terminology relating to the online services platform (Bid Price, Bid Quantity, Ask Price, Ask Quantity, LTP, etc.)

The third session by a Tax Expert scanned the recently implemented tax regime, the GST. The expert gave an overview comparing the previous tax system with the prevailing one. The students also gain knowledge on various jargons such as GSTIN and HSN Code.

The last session focused on the working mechanism and importance of NPS (National Pension System). The speaker established the theory on how an employee not under a pension scheme of the employer can enrol in the scheme and derive its benefits.

Throughout the session, students were fully engrossed in the discussion and cleared their dilemmas by putting up various questions to the speakers.


Following measures have been initiated by IQAC for enhancing sensitivity towards environmental sustainability.


Waste Management Practices

Aryabhatta College has been proactive in addressing the issue of waste generated at the campus. The following measures have been initiated in this regard:

Solid Waste Management

College has collaborated with JAAGRUTI Waste Paper Recycling Services to recycle waste paper since 2016. Collection of waste paper is ensured periodically and in turn, Jaagruti provides the college reams and notepads made of recycled paper. This has contributed towards reduction in the stationary cost incurred by the college.





Compost Pit in the college ensures recycling of biodegradable and horticulture waste produced within the premises. The compost piles function as an environment-friendly and cost-effective alternative to expensive chemical fertilizers.



College has a MoU with Chintan NGO to segregate dry waste and wet waste, besides ensuring collection of hazardous waste. Training of gardeners in composting and awareness generation amongst teaching and non-teaching staff is done regularly.

Project Palaash by Enactus Aryabhatta ensures effective and steady waste management as the bio-waste generated from the dyeing process is used to create compost which is re-utilized for growing flowers, ensuring sustainability.



Project Ibitda by Enactus Aryabhatta is a one-stop solution that simultaneously tackles the problem of stubble burning, carbon emissions from the construction industries, mass generation of plastic products, and agricultural waste.



College has incrementally moved towards e-administration in all domains leading to a decrease in paper consumption.

Liquid Waste Management

Drinking water requirement in the college is met by two large Reverse Osmosis (RO) purifiers.

A herbal garden is being maintained at the college campus by using the wastewater generated by the RO system.

Aryabhatta College has one of the largest rainwaters harvesting tanks in Delhi University. The pit size of the rain water harvesting unit is 20.5x4x4 meters. Its capacity is about 3.28 lakh litres. The storm drain at the top of the terrace is directly connected to the rain water harvesting unit. The unit covers the catchment area behind Kusumpur block, Taregna block and other open areas in the college.

Regular checks for possible leakages are conducted from time to time.

E-Waste Management

College has an MOU with RBH E-Waste Recycle Hub Pvt Ltd for collection of condemned and old IT Scrap and e-waste. The Computer Science department has initiated an awareness drive on environmental hazards of e-waste in collaboration with Karo Sambhav, one of India's leading Producer Responsibility Organisation (PRO) under the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology's (MeitY).

E-waste collection drives are conducted by the college periodically.

Our college has a designated E-Waste Management Committee which maintains an inventory of e-waste generated at the college premises.

The college has a Disabled-friendly washroom at the ground floor and one designated, in particular, for disabled women students.



The campus has signages for tactile path, lights, display boards and signposts.



The library has a designated space on the ground floor for disabled students to access e-resources from Delhi university central library and the visually challenged can access e-braille books. The library has installed NVDA software, an open-source software to enable screen reading and browsing of websites for the visually challenged students and teachers.
