4.	Publication of Final List of Candidates	Wednesday, the 05 <sup>th</sup> September, 2018 till 5:00 PM
5.	Date of Election	Friday, the 7 <sup>th</sup> September, 2018
6.	Timings of Voting	10:30 AM to 12:30 PM
7.	Counting of Votes	7 <sup>th</sup> September, 2018 at 1:00 PM.

- All students desirous of contesting the elections are required to fill nomination form available from the Student Dealing office and should be submitted to the concerned Teacher In-Charges.
- One representative from the following courses will be elected :- B.A. (H) Business Economics, B.A. (Prog.), B.Com (H), B.Com, B.Sc. (H) Computer Science, B.A. (H) Economics, B.A. (H) English, B.A. (H) Hindi, B.A. (H) History, B.A.(H) Political Science, B.Sc. (H) Mathematics, B.A. (H) Psychology, Bachelor in Management Studies.
- The Form duly filled should be accompanied by a copy of the Fee Receipt, previous year result and a copy of college identity card.
- All the students who have paid their College fee till 01.09.2018 are eligible to participate in the election process.
- The candidate should be between the age of 17 to 22 years as on 16<sup>th</sup> August, 2018.
- All code of conduct as per Lyngdoh Committee will be applicable.

**ELIGIBILITY :-**

- 58% marks in the last examination passed (for first year students it shall be 60%)
- 80 % attendance in the last academic session (For the first year students' attendance of July & august shall be considered or the endorsement/certification by the department of his/her regularity.
- Good conduct in the college and active participation in the departmental activities.

As per the Constitution of the Students' Council, 03 of the 13 seats are required to be reserved for girl candidates with a view to achieve adequate representations of girls in the Council. As per Annexure-1 of the said Constitution, seats for girl candidate shall be reserved in the following Departments: - Business Economics, Hindi, and History for the year 2018-19.
