5.	Publication of final list of candidates	Wednesday, the 05 <sup>th</sup> September,2018 till 5:00 PM
6.	Date of Election	Wednesday, the 12th September, 2018
7.	Timings of Voting	8:30 AM to 1:00 PM
8.	Counting of Votes	12th September, 2018 at 1:30 PM.

#### NOTE:

- All students desirous of contesting the elections are required to apply to Shri Sunil Lingwal, S.O. (Admn.) in writing.
- The Form duly filled and accompanied by a demand draft of Rs. 500/- drawn in favour of Principal, Aryabhatta College; a copy of fee slip; previous result and College Identity Card should be submitted to the S.O. (Admn.).
- All the students who have paid their College fee till 01.09.2018 are eligible to participate in the election process.
- The candidate is required to mention his/her residential address along with contact number on the backside of the Nomination Form.
- The candidate should have attained the minimum percentage of attendance as prescribed by the University or 75% attendance, whichever is higher.
- The election for the Central Council is subject to approval of the competent authority.
- The candidate should in no event have any academic arrears in the year of contesting the election. Any pending paper(s) will be construed as academic arrear(s). Candidates failed in the preceding academic year and/or re-admitted in the current academic year will not be eligible to contest the election.
- The candidate should be between the age of 17 to 22 years as on 16th August, 2018.

Every candidate is required to furnish an affidavit to the effect:-

(i) that he/she does not have any previous criminal record and has not been subjected to any disciplinary action by the University/College.

(ii) that he/she has not failed in the preceding academic year and/or re-admitted in the current
