A REPORT

Nibs and Brushes for its official fest 'RIWAYAT' held a workshop on 'Lippan Art' for the year '24. The workshop was held on 15th February 2024 at 2:30 PM in Multipurpose Hall. Registrations were open for students from all around universities. *Riwayat* garnered a participation of ten people including on the spot registration. Materials like mirrors, boards, mould etc. were provided by the society itself and stationary items were to be brought by the participants.



The event heads - Anjali and Bhanu - being finely experienced artists of Lippan Art from the society, initiated the workshop with a brief introduction to this cultural art form. Lippan art is a traditional mural craft of Kutch, Gujarat, India, composing usually of mud and mirror.

The Mud-mirror work gathered attention of the modern world for its intricate pattern and aesthetic perfection and has made a full transition from its unknown modest stature to the mainstream art world, decorating the walls of rural homes.
