Seminar Report

On February 24, 2025, the B.A. Programme Society, Arahata, hosted a seminar on Interview Guidance in the Student Activity Room at Aryabhatta College, University of Delhi from 12:30 pm onwards. This event was designed to equip aspiring students with advanced interview techniques, enhance their confidence-building skills, and help them differentiate themselves in a competitive workplace environment. A total of 80 students attended the seminar. Students from different courses were present.
