REPORT OF AAVAAHAN '24

Abstract

TechPioneers organized two events- **Typeracer and Meme-o-Meter** under the flagship of **Aavaahan '24, the annual cultural fest of Aryabhatta College, on 29th April 2024** which had multiple cultural fun-filled events for all. With the dedicated team efforts, the event was a huge success with good participation from students from different colleges.

TYPERACER

TechPioneers organized Typeracer- a speed typing competition on 29th April 2024, under the flagship of Aryabhatta College's annual fest **Aavaahan'24**. Typeracer, which was a competitive and two-rounds speed typing competition, was open to students from all disciplines.

Objective:

Type Racers is a premier typing competition event that gives a platform to all participants to demonstrate their prowess in typing. With a focus on fast typing and participants to type. This event also serves as a platform to evaluate participant's accuracy through different challenges in the field of typing while honing critical response abilities.

Summary:

The competition took place in two rounds, each with two parts. The format was designed to challenge the participants and reward consistency and precision in typing.

Round 1

Round 1 featured 12 participants who competed in two parts wherein they have to write a 150-200 words paragraph in the timeframe of 3 minutes. Participants were required to showcase their typing abilities while maintaining a minimum accuracy of 80% to qualify for the next round. The performance in both parts was assessed based on their speed and accuracy and the highest score from each part was considered as the participants' points. This method ensured that participants were evaluated based on their best performance and could advance based on their typing speed and accuracy. Out of the 12 participants, 6 proceeded to Round 2 based on their performance in the first round.

Round 2

In Round 2, the 6 finalists competed in two parts of 5 minutes each. This longer duration tested the participants' accuracy and focus, adding an extra layer of challenge to the competition. The participants demonstrated exceptional typing speed and accuracy. The final results were determined by the participants' performance in Round 2, with the top 2 competitors emerging as winners.

The competition concluded with the announcement of the winners, acknowledging their exceptional skills. The event was a great success, offering students an opportunity to engage in friendly competition while honing their typing abilities. It also fostered a sense of community and collaboration among participants and attendees, contributing to the overall success of the college's annual fest.

Objective:


