
REPORT ON AARUNYA'25: Departmental Fest of BA Programme

Held on 9th April 2025

The Department of BA Programme proudly organized its first-ever departmental fest, AARUNYA'25, on **9th April 2025**, marking the beginning of a new tradition within the department. Envisioned as an annual cultural celebration, AARUNYA'25 was conceptualized to encourage academic excellence, creativity, and a sense of community among students and faculty alike. The name " **AARUNYA**", symbolizing the first rays of the sun, reflects the fest's purpose, to illuminate the path for future celebrations and foster a vibrant departmental identity.



The day began with a formal introduction to AARUNYA and its vision. This was followed by the ceremonial banner reveal, an event that symbolized the official launch of the fest. Following the inauguration, the fest commenced with a seminar on "Importance of Multidisciplinary approach in NEP" held from 10:30 a.m. to 12:00 p. m. in the

This was followed by performances from around **7 to 8 participants**, who took the stage to express themselves through poetry, music, storytelling, and other creative formats.
