Project Utkarsh

- Project Utkarsh takes on the challenge of unhealthy eating habits and food wastage and makes delicious, healthy chips - Vegittos - out of food pulp and the love of our women beneficiaries.

Project Palaash

- Project Palaash tackles the issue of improper floral waste management by collecting discarded flowers and transforming them into natural and sustainable dyes while providing livelihood enhancement opportunities to economically disadvantaged people.

Project Ibtida

- Project Ibtida addresses the daunting issue of climate change by upcycling unexplored sources of pollution into innovative and carbon-negative products and provides income-generation opportunities to the artisans.



What is Project Utkarsh?

In addition to the problem of food waste, unhealthy snacking habits cannot be disregarded. Nowadays many people, regardless of age, have developed a habit of munching on unhealthy snacks leading to bad health. 
This innovative project has the potential to make a substantial impact within and beyond India.
