We installed drop boxes all around our campus and got a great response from everyone. Most of the decoration material used and products sold at Enactus Day were made from these.

Enactus Aryabhata, in collaboration with Youth for Seva NGO, participated in an interactive and fun-filled initiative called "Story-fied" wherein members of our team went to a school run for underprivileged children to teach them certain important morales and values through means of storytelling to make it interesting. Our members returned with smiles on their faces from all the love and warmth they received from the kids and with a stronger determination to carry the spirit of enactus forward.
7. We also went forward with Pehchaan, an initiative where we approached

people with different lifestyles, backgrounds and communities to listen to their diverse life stories and provided a platform where help can be delivered to those in need.
