About :

- We, at Enactus Aryabhata, are a team of more than 80 students from different backgrounds such as Economics, Maths, Psychology, Political Science, and History, striving to alleviate the exigent challenges that afflict our society by using business and innovation concepts enabling individuals to be a part of their own success, hereby ensuring judicious use of resources, significantly reducing wastage, promoting recycling and working towards building a community that is socially, economically and environmentally sustained.
- The three fold objectives of ENACTUS have included- targeting environmental concerns, providing market based solutions as well as uplifting the marginalised groups as its beneficiaries.
- Since its inception in 2016, Enactus Aryabhata has undertaken seven community outreach initiatives to date, four of which have been consummated and four of which are still running. Project Utkarsh, Project Palaash, Project Ibtida, and Project Aarazi are our three active initiatives.
- Project Utkarsh takes on the challenge of unhealthy eating habits and food wastage and makes delicious, healthy chips - Vegittos - out of food pulp and the love of our women beneficiaries.
- Project Palaash tackles the issue of improper floral waste management by collecting discarded flowers and transforming them into natural and sustainable dyes while providing livelihood enhancement opportunities to economically disadvantaged people.
- Project Ibtida addresses the daunting issue of climate change by upcycling unexplored sources of pollution into innovative and carbon-negative products and provides income-generation opportunities to the artisans.
- Project Aarazi ardently endeavors to address the pressing issue of soil pollution and land degradation stemming from the rampant use of chemical fertilizers and pesticides. This initiative is dedicated to formulating organic fertilizers and pesticides, comprising entirely natural ingredients and homemade concoctions.

Campaigns:

Enactus Aryabhata took proactive measures to combat the seasonal surge in floral waste during and around Indian festivals by introducing a diverse range of seasonal campaigns. These campaigns focus on offering sustainable alternatives to customary festival essentials to our valued customers.

Abir

Through our Holi campaign - ABIR, Enactus Aryabhata skillfully converted floral waste into organic, vibrant, fragrant, and skin-friendly gulaal. The campaign was organized in February 2024 from 15 February to 24 March in Delhi NCR and was a success owing to the participation of 90 students and 2 teachers.



Utsav

During Diwali - The festival of lights, Enactus Aryabhata's Utsav campaign endeavored to illuminate cleaner flames by producing attar-infused soy wax candles. The campaign was organized in November 2023 from 15 October to 12 November and garnered notable engagement from 90 students and 3 teachers in the Delhi NCR region.



Anagha






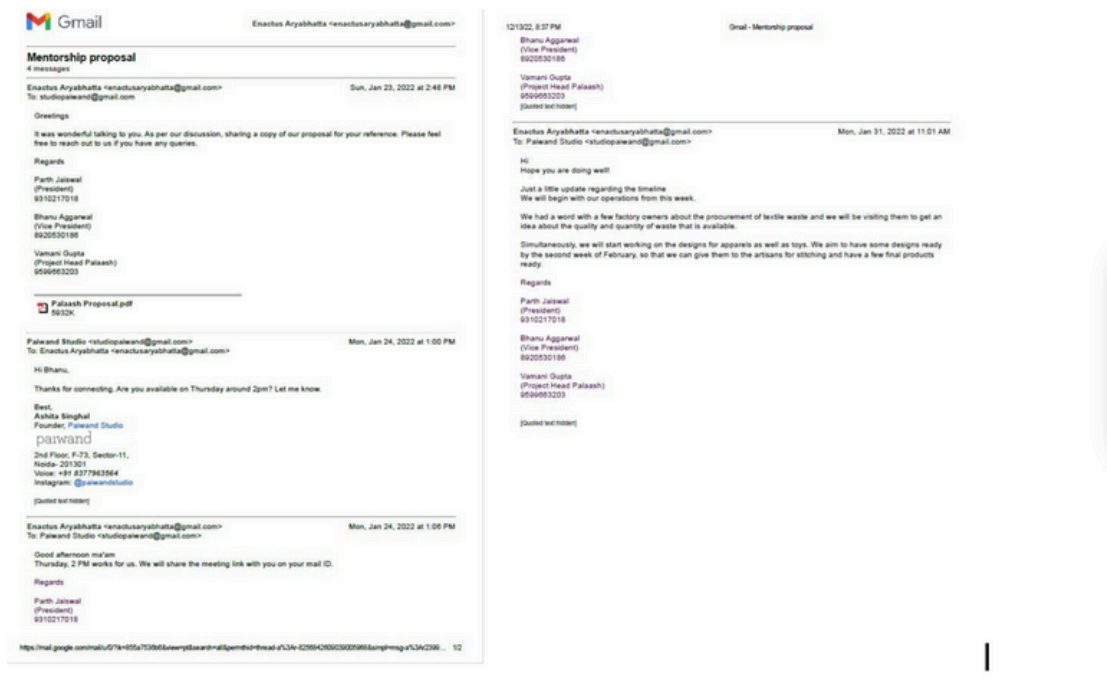
Aryabhata College DU- The college campus has adopted our centralized composting model.
