About:

- We, at Enactus Aryabhatta, are a team of more than 80 students from different backgrounds such as Economics, Maths, Psychology, Political Science, and History, striving to alleviate the exigent challenges that afflict our society by using business and innovation concepts enabling individuals to be a part of their own success, hereby ensuring judicious use of resources, significantly reducing wastage, promoting recycling and working towards building a community that is socially, economically and environmentally sustained.
- The three fold objectives of ENACTUS have included- targeting environmental concerns, providing market based solutions as well as uplifting the marginalised groups as its beneficiaries.
- Since its inception in 2016, Enactus Aryabhatta has undertaken seven community outreach initiatives to date, four of which have been consummated and four of which are still running. Project Utkarsh, Project Palaash, Project Ibtida, and Project Aarazi are our three active initiatives.
- Project Utkarsh takes on the challenge of unhealthy eating habits and food wastage and makes delicious, healthy chips Vegittos out of food pulp and the love of our women beneficiaries.
- Project Palaash tackles the issue of improper floral waste management by collecting discarded flowers and transforming them into natural and sustainable dyes while providing livelihood enhancement opportunities to economically disadvantaged people.
- Project Ibtida addresses the daunting issue of climate change by upcycling unexplored sources of pollution into innovative and carbonnegative products and provides income-generation opportunities to the artisans.
- Project Aarazi ardently endeavors to address the pressing issue of soil
 pollution and land degradation stemming from the rampant use of
 chemical fertilizers and pesticides. This initiative is dedicated to
 formulating organic fertilizers and pesticides, comprising entirely
 natural ingredients and homemade concoctions.

Campaigns:

Enactus Aryabhatta took proactive measures to combat the seasonal surge in floral waste during and around Indian festivals by introducing a diverse range of seasonal campaigns. These campaigns focus on offering sustainable alternatives to customary festival essentials to our valued customers.

Abir

Through our Holi campaign - ABIR, Enactus Aryabhatta skillfully converted floral waste into organic, vibrant, fragrant, and skin-friendly gulaal. The campaign was organized in February 2024 from 15 February to 24 March in Delhi NCR and was a success owing to the participation of 90 students and 2 teachers.



Utsav

During Diwali - The festival of lights, Enactus Aryabhatta's Utsav campaign endeavored to illuminate cleaner flames by producing attar-infused soy wax candles. The campaign was organized in November 2023 from 15 October to 12 November and garnered notable engagement from 90 students and 3 teachers in the Delhi NCR region.

Crafted from the earth, for the earth- Anagha was a new initiative by Enactus Aryabhatta. Prototypes of Hemp bags were manufactured and a stall was for the sales of the same on the college campus to see the potential it had in the market.

Stop India and Enactus Arvabhatta will share profits in the ratio of 7:3. where 70% of profit will be given to the beneficiaries of Stop India, and remaining 30% is retained by Enactus Aryabhatta for future expansion of the project. All payments to Stop India and transfer of money shall be done on monthly basis.

- 3) Technical Expertise: Stop India shall help Enactus Aryabhatta in establishing the technical expertise required to undertake the project (dyeing). While, Enactus Aryabhatta shall provide tech-based support in relevant domains (videography, marketing, operations etc.) to Stop India in any relevant domain it seeks help for.
- 4) Dispute Settlement: Dispute (if any) arises between the two parties, shall be solved on mutual discussion and deliberation. Both the parties will work with co-operation and in best faith so as to uphold the commitments made for this collaboration.
- 5) Termination of the collaboration: In case any of the parties wish to terminate the collaboration then it must do so by providing a show cause notice to the counter party, 1 month prior to the termination.
- 6) Market Linkage- Complete market transparency will be ensured by Enactus Aryabhatta, in terms of the buyers ordering the products from the website and their complete details.
